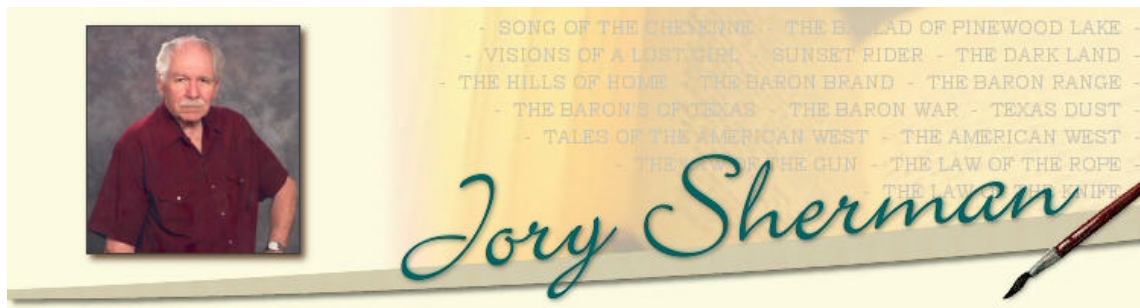

The course will cover: generating the story, setting the first scene, drawing characters, plotting the story or novel, definitions, point of view, selling your story or novel, how to find and query an agent, and professional tips on selling your ideas. Students will plot a novel, write a first chapter, and a plot summary.
